Josh Davidson, DMD, MPH, is a 2011 graduate of A. T. Still University Arizona School of Dentistry & Oral Health (ASDOH). He is currently employed by Marshfield Clinic, a Federally Qualified Healthcare Center, and practices in Chippewa Falls, WI. Dr. Davidson is a consultant for the senior care website, ecarediary.com, addressing dental care for seniors, and an active member of the ASDOH Alumni Board.

Dr. Clark Chen is a 2012 graduate of A. T. Still University Arizona School of Dentistry and Oral Health. After completion of a Prosthodontic residency at the University of California San Francisco in 2015, he returned to Arizona. He is currently an Assistant Professor in the Prosthodontics department of Arizona School of Dentistry & Oral Health.



Dr. Matthew Kahn is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists. He received his DDS degree from the University of Maryland Dental School in Baltimore, Maryland in 2003 and completed a prosthetics residency at the Naval Postgraduate Dental School. Dr. Kahn is a Reserve Officer in the Navy Dental Corps after completing ten years of active service in the United States Navy. Currently an Assistant Professor of Prosthodontics at ASDOH, he is a member of the American Dental Association, Arizona Dental

Association, and the American College of Prosthodontics. Dr. Kahn's professional interests include comprehensive restorative and prosthodontic care with an emphasis on prevention and esthetic reconstructions. Dr. Kahn frequently lectures on dental materials, dentures, and pathologic tooth wear.
